The East Haddam Probate records, Vol. vii. p. 431, (preserved at Colchester) mention the heirs of Lieut. David Day, among whom are "the heirs of Lydia Fuller." These, with the inscriptions, prove convincingly that Lydia Day was the mother of Joseph Fuller's children.
