12. **Bartholomew West**, son of Bartholomew West and Catherine Almy, died in 1766. He had a daughter, Margaret West, who married Philip Edwards. They had a son, Stephen, who married Deborah West, daughter of John and Lydia (Worthley) West.

Samuel West, born in 1750 in Salem, New York, married **Peaceable Hubbell**, born in 1757/8. They were the parents of one son. Samuel served in the Revolution in the New York line, and moved to New Milford, Connecticut, after his marriage. He and his wife are buried in Milton, Litchfield County. Their descendants returned to New York before 1830, and migrated from there to Wisconsin, Illinois, and other Western States. **The son, Hubbell West, born in Amenia, New York**, had ten daughters. One of his descendants is Mrs. Lucy Woodward Vauthier, of Millersville, Maryland, who is a member of the D. A. R. **Hubbell West** also had one son, Samuel Chamberlain West, born in Colebrook, Connecticut, June 26, 1818. A descendant, Gordon R. West, is reclamation engineer for the Missouri Pacific Lines. He makes his home in St. Louis. His father was Henry Titus West, and his grandfather Henry T. West was the son of Samuel Chamberlain West. This branch of the West family originated in Connecticut and is no doubt connected with the early New England line.
