WARM OVERCOATS FOR BOYS

Coffee and Milk Stains may be removed from silk, woolen or other fabrics by painting over with glycerine and then washing with a linen rag dipped in lukewarm rain water. It is afterwards pressed on the wrong side with a moderately warm iron as long as it seems damp. The most delicate colors are unaffected by this treatment.

Grease Spots.—For white linen or cotton goods use soap or weak lye; for colored calicoes, warm soap-suds; for woolens, soap-suds or ammonia, with a dash of camphor; for silk, wash with water.
