by land, 27 Bbls flour, at 10/ p^r. bbl transp^r.
22 Barrels Provisions & 10 Bbls Pot Ashes at 5/
p^r. Cwt, he likewise advised me that he had
sent 10 fkins lard which has not yet come
to hand, - accompanying the above articles he
has sent his acct. for transporting the same from
Utica to L. falls Storage & Co. at the falls 27⁸⁰/₁₀₀
or 27⁸⁰/₁₀₀ Bbl prime pork, ^{dollars} balance \$20.80, ^{from} which
he has drawn on me in favour of Mr. Jacob Fort
of Albany, the above articles I have ship^d to N. York
