

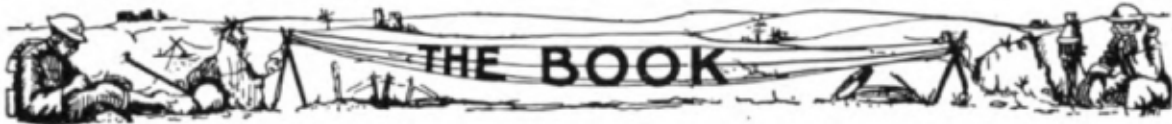

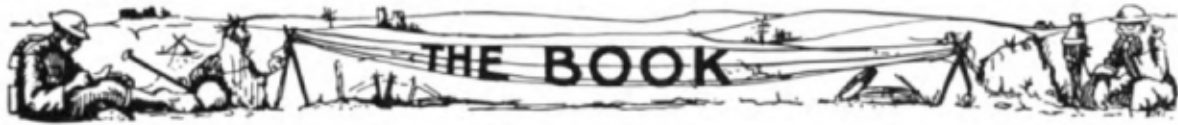
Camp Merritt, New Jersey, April 19, 1919.

## After the Armistice

After the first few days of readjustment of our minds to the fact that we were in no danger from shells unless we kicked the cap of a "dud," and that it was unnecessary to spend our pay frantically and feverishly as soon as we got it, a period of remarkable monotony set in.

We were first gathered in the city of Audenarde and billeted in a convent and several stores and private residences, where we enjoyed checking up our equipment on several lists in the old-time Camp Lewis style. Also we received about seven chocolate creams per man, a very sweet thing to remember.

One glorious morning we started forth on a rather long hike to Michelbeke. Some of the men had very thin soled shoes and the hike was especially hard for them. It was at this point that our Company commander made the famous statement that was long remembered by those who heard



it: "You men are getting soft from riding in trucks!" We looked down at the "trucks" with their hob-nailed treads that most of us had been riding on, and those who could let a lip slip smiled.

In Michelbeke we were billeted in a schoolhouse, C Company drawing the most stairs to climb and no stoves. Rabbit feeds became in order at once. They were a great relief from the habitual "bully beef" stew, and everybody felt francs spent on Belgian hares were francs well invested. But the rabbit markets were not within camp confines and several men who went outside for "eats" were caught. Unpleasant were the consequences.

About this time the powers that be decided that now was the time to train us for another war and school days set in again. Lieutenant Whittell read and expounded to us the revered army regulations. Sergeant Haines showed the men mysteries of a four drop-board and **Corporal Hubbell** explained Ohms law to a company of bored and snoring soldiers. Infantry drill also was started.
