

**Hubbel Run** 

Hubbel Run, which branches off French Creek, is located in Amity Township, just south of Wattsburg.

There's more than one way to look at Hubbel Run.

It's spelled "Hubbel" on modern maps but referred to as "Hubbell" in old history texts.

The creek is named after Jabez G Hubbell, who was born in Connecticut and grew up in Otsego County, N.Y., before moving to Amity Township with his wife, Maria, in 1828.

They settled on and cleared more than 100 acres of wilderness. Hubbel Run is so named because it flows through the Hubbels' homestead, according to "History of Erie County, Pennsylvania" by Samuel Bates
