

Chemical Warfare Service 1st Gas Regiment (Gas and Flame) 2nd Lt. **John Platt Hubbell (ME# 7194)** of Palmerton, PA Autographed 1919 United States Postal Stationary Postcard to Williams College which he was being awarded the Williams Medal, class of 1913 his brother was with the 216 Squadron Royal Air Force and Pilot **Sherwood Hubbell** and another brother named **George L. Hubbell** from Garden City New York who was a lawyer and all three of them attended Williams College. John P. Hubbell son was **Dr. John P. Hubbell Jr.**, 92, of Cambridge, Massachusetts where he was a resident of Cadbury Commons.
