From Cutter, page 149: "**Julius Caesar, son of Wolcott Hubbell**, was born at Lanesborough, Massachusetts, April 17 1787, died at Chazy, New York, aged ninety-three years. At the age of fifteen years he walked from Lanesborough, Massachusetts, to Burlington, Vermont; there took a boat and rowed to the mouth of Champlain river, now the Big Chazy river, and walked to Champlain, where his brother, Silas P. Hubbell, was practicing law, he having gone there some years previous. There he studied law with his brother, serving some seven years, the last three years doing most of the office business. He later walked from Champlain to Chazy, where he established himself in the profession of law, which he continued successfully until his death. He married Anna, daughter of Judge Pliny Moore, of Champlain, New York."
