Levi M. Hubbell (July 14, 1826 – December 23, 1910) was an <u>American</u> businessman and politician.

Born in <u>Fairfield County</u>, <u>Connecticut</u>, Hubbell was educated at the <u>Oneida Institute</u>; he then moved to <u>Bradford</u>, <u>Iowa</u> in <u>Chickasaw County</u>, <u>Iowa</u>, in 1859, where he worked in business. Then he moved to <u>Winneshiek County</u>, <u>Iowa</u> where he farmed and finally moved to <u>Waukon</u>, <u>Iowa</u> in 1879 where he died. Hubbell served in the <u>Iowa House of Representatives</u> 1880-1884
