

Levi M. Hubbell (July 14, 1826 – December 23, 1910) was an [American](#) businessman and politician.

Born in [Fairfield County, Connecticut](#), Hubbell was educated at the [Oneida Institute](#); he then moved to [Bradford, Iowa](#) in [Chickasaw County, Iowa](#), in 1859, where he worked in business. Then he moved to [Winneshiek County, Iowa](#) where he farmed and finally moved to [Waukon, Iowa](#) in 1879 where he died. Hubbell served in the [Iowa House of Representatives](#) 1880-1884.^{[1][2]}
