This snapshot, courtesy of Lia Kaufman, shows Pedro Castle as it was many years ago.

"My father was friends with **Mr. Tom Hubbell** who ran Pedro Castle before any restaurant [opened there]," said Kaufman.

Hubbell died in a small plane crash at Owen Roberts International Airport on 13 Dec. 1977. He was 54 years old. He was one of the first four people to offer diving and snorkelling trips in Cayman, starting in 1961, and also spearheaded efforts to renovate and reopen Pedro St. James.
