TWENTIETH ANNUAL MEETING
OF THE
AMERICAN TRACT SOCIETY.

THE Twentieth Anniversary of this Society was held in the Broadway Tabernacle, New-York, May 7, 1845. The Hon. THEODORE FRELINGHUYSEN, President, in the Chair; supported by Rev. Lyman Beecher, D. D. Rev. Philip Milledoler, D. D. and Peter G. Stuyvesant, William B. Crosby, and John Tappan, Esqrs. Vice-Presidents. Prayer having been offered by Rev. David Magie, of Elizabethtown, New Jersey, the Treasurer's Report was read by Moses Allen, Esq. and the Annual Report, Publishing and Foreign Departments by Wm. A. Hallock, Domestic Operations by R. S. Cook, Secretaries. The following resolutions were then presented, and unanimously adopted: viz.

On motion of Rev. Lyman Beecher, D. D. of the Presbyterian Church, Cincinnati, Ohio;

Seconded by Rev. Leonard Bacon, D. D. of the Congregational Church, New Haven, Connecticut;

Resolved, That the Report, an abstract of which has now been read, be adopted and published under the direction of the Executive Committee.

On motion of the Rev. John Knox, D. D. of the Reformed Dutch Church, New-York, member of the Executive Committee;

Seconded by John Tappan, Esq. President of the American Tract Society at Boston;

Resolved, That, while the Society recognize with devout gratitude to God his smiles and protection during the twenty years of its existence, and rejoice to commit its future interests to him, they bow with humble submission to the recent dispensation of his providence in the sudden removal of the Rev. Dr. MILNOR, whose devoted and faithful labors as chairman of the Publishing and Executive Committees have been identified with the prosperity of the Society from the time of its formation.

On motion of Rev. H. V. D. Johns, D. D. of the Protestant Episcopal Church, Baltimore, Maryland;

Seconded by Rev. S. S. Schmucker, D. D. of the Evangelical Lutheran Church, Professor, Theological Seminary, Gettysburg, Penn.

Resolved, That this Society rejoice in the bond that unites them in the one work of making known Christ and his salvation.

The congregation then united in singing the hymn, "All hail the power of Jesu' name," &c.
