Major M. J. Hubble, of the Atlantic and Pacific, arrived on Tuesday last from the Indian Nation, and informs us that the Atlantic and Pacific Railroad crossed Grand River bridge on the 14th inst., and by the 1st proximo the road will receive and ship cattle five miles South-West of Grand River. Grand River is about 70 miles North of Fort Gibson. The Major informs us that a large number of droves are coming to the terminus of the Atlantic and Pacific road, from Abilene, looking for buyers, the parties purchasing cattle preferring this point to Abilene, it being only 343 miles to St. Louis, whilst Abilene is 443 miles from St. Louis, besides necessitating a change of cars at Kansas City.
