ACCIDENT.—From John F. Miller, Esq., of Maysville, we learn the particulars of a sad, if not fatal accident that happened to the **son of Gabriel Hubbel**, of Jackson township, on Wednesday of last week. **Daniel Hubbel**, aged about 15 years, was employed in the steam mill at Maysville, and while attending to some of the machinery, was caught by the shaft, and was revolved some 200 or 300 times before its motion was stopped.
