He and the driver were killed and their bodies have been found near the road. The stage and the horses have not been recovered. It is also stated that during a special session of the district court in Uvalde county, the Indians entered the county, killed a young man, son of Mr. Wm. Cox. who lives four miles from Uvaide, stole horses and committed other depredations.
