

DEATH FROM DRINK.—Last Sunday, (the 16th) one David Hubble, a half-caste, and others went on an okolehao spree at Kula, near Makawao, Maui. That night Hubble was missed, and was not seen again till Tuesday, when his dead body was found at the foot of a precipice, some 100 feet high. A coroner's jury returned a verdict to the effect that he came to his death by falling over the precipice. There are however suspicions of foul play. BUSINESS.—Sheriff Everett has broken up the okolehao distillery at Kula, Maui, where David Hubble lost his life as reported in our last. On the 25th inst, in the District Court of Makawao, three parties, a woman and two men, were fined \$500 each for selling, and one man was fined \$150 and sentenced to 18 months imprisonment for furnishing; all noted appeals. Suspicion exists that there was foul play in Hubble's case, and the Sheriff is thoroughly investigating the matter.
