The Convention To-day.

NEW HAVEN, Sept. 17. — The democratic state convention met in Music Hall this forenoon, every town in the state being represented. Hon. Francis A. Marden was chosen permanent president. The committee on resolutions are in favor of "soft money."

The old state ticket, headed by **Erhart D. Hubble, of Hartford**, for governor, was nominated by acclamation.

The declination of Francis B. Loomis, for Lieut. Governor, was read, and his declination was accepted.

Hon. Charles Durand, of Derby, was nominated by acclamation, and accepted.
