Corporal Walter E. Hubble, of the United States Army, of Baton Rouge, was the recruiting officer. He stated that while enlistment was not large the percentage was excellent, seven out of nine being found physically sound. The average in New Orleans was one in five.

Postmaster Seiler makes the announcement that if there are others who wish to enlist he will take their names and have a recruiting officer come over and examine them. If they should go and not be accepted the government will pay their return expenses home.
