Rewards Given for Capture of Convicts

(By the Associated Press) Sioux Falls, S. D., Sept. 8 .- Rewards for the capture of the four convicts who staged the most sensational escape in the history of South Dakota penitentiary last August 17, were announced by the board of charities and corrections this morning. The rewards total \$600 of which \$150 goes to Rev. Wm. J. Cole of Wasta, S. D., who was a member of a posse and took J. B. King, the last of the four desperadoes to surrender, single handed after the pitched battle near Wall in which one of the convicts was killed and two captured. The remaining \$450 is equally divided between Theron Hubble, C. C. Kline, E. B. Townsend and A. T. Wilson, all of Murdo, S. D., who killed Coffee and captured Jee Foreman and Henry Teel, the other fugitives. There were numbers of other claimants for the rewards.
