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PREFACE

This record of marriages covers all the entries in the Boston newspaper entitled the *Massachusetts Centinel* from 1784 to 1790 and the *Columbian Centinel* from 1790 to 1840 - specifically from March 24, 1784 to April 29, 1840. The marriages are arranged in one alphabetical order, under name of both husband and wife, and comprise nearly 80,000 names. Few marriages were recorded in the early period and it was not until the late 1790's that even a half dozen marriages were entered in each semi-weekly issue. However, from 1800 to 1840 the number greatly increased, each week providing in its two issues as many as twenty marriages or forty names as they would be entered in this list.

The value of the list lies in the fact that the *Centinel* copied the marriage records from all newspapers which were received in exchange from various parts of the country. As a result, a considerable number of marriage records are found for states in the South and the West, as well as on the Atlantic seaboard. Of the 80,000 names here recorded, about 27% are of Boston, 40% of Massachusetts except Boston, 16% of New England outside of Massachusetts, and 17% of the rest of the country beyond New England.

This work was compiled in 1941 under the supervision of the American Antiquarian Society and the work of indexing and typing was performed through W.P.A. aid.
