Andrew Casey married Mandy Hubble, a sister of Sarah Hubble. Mandy lived but a short while after their marriage. In 1900, Andrew J. Casey was residing alone (listed as a widower) in Newton County, Arkansas. Andrew Casey married a second time to Lula Jackson. Andrew and Lula Casey were the parents of six children:
