* Amos Hubbel, who m. 1783, Lucy Holms, was a son of Ephraim Hubbell, the Justice of the Peace, who m. the foregoing 144 couples, and before his marriage had been a soldier in the Revolution. His widow, in making application for pension in 1838, sent to the Pension Office at Washington, the original record of the foregoing marriages to prove her own marriage. In 1878, the Pension Office returned the said original record to the New Fairfield Town Clerk, and in April, 1885, they were in his safe, but have since disappeared.
