*William Smith* of said *Fairfield* To Appear  
before the \_\_\_\_\_ County Court to be Holden at *Fairfield*  
within and for the County of *Fairfield* On the *third* Tuesday of  
*William Smith* Then and there to Answer unto  
*David Hubble of Fairfield*

In a Plea of the Case, whereupon the Plaintiff declares, That the Defendant by a cer-  
tain Writing (or Note) under his Hand by him well Executed, Dated *March 31*  
*1746* Promised the Plaintiff to Pay to  
*William Smith* the Sum of *fourty four pounds 5/4*  
*William Smith* at or before the *first* Day of *Julian* *April*

As by said Writing (or Note) ready in Court to be shewn, appears:  
Now the Plaintiff farther says, That the Defendant his Promise  
aforesaid not in the least Regard, hath never Performed the same ( Though  
often Requested ) Which is to the Damage of the Plaintiff ( as he says ) the Sum of  
*fourty five pound money of Lenow*

And to Recover the same with just Costs, the Plaintiff bring this Suit. [ ]  
Hereof Fail not, but make Return hereof with your Doings  
thereon according to Law. Dated at *Fairfield* the *7<sup>th</sup>*  
Day of *April* Anno Domini, 1747 And in the *20<sup>th</sup>* Year  
of His Majesty's Reign.
