CHRIST EPISCOPAL CHURCH CEMETERY
REVOLUTIONARY WAR AND WAR OF 1812 PATRIOTS

The letter and numbers before the Patriot's name is a grid map # where the Patriot can be located in the cemetery.

1. J21 – **Beardslee, Abijah**, B-1 Jan 1764 died 3 Sept 1839. His Pension # 17278. Private under Lieut. Patterson in Whiting's CT. Regiment. He was stationed at Stratford where he guarded the town for 8 months. B-1764, D-3/Sep/1839.
2. NO8 – **Beardslee, Abraham**, B-1726, D-13/Feb/1815. He was an inspector of Gun powder and maker of Guns. SAR & DAR applications. In Capt. Booths Reg. called to defend the coast from July 5th to the 9th 1779. DAR # A008095.
3. NO7 – **Beardslee, Curtiss, Corporal** B- 9 Aug 1754 died 15 Sept 1796. SAR & DAR applications. He was a Corporal in Capt. Wheelers Co. under Col. Lewis from 26 Aug 1776 in the battle of Long Island. B- 1752, D-13/Sep/1796. DAR # A008101
4. B23 – **Beardslee, Henry**, B-1737, D-3/Aug/1806. Hale Collection Rev. War, Ct. Revolutionary War Military List 1775-83. 4th Regiment Capt. Booth Co. under General Silliman, Ration Rolls. History of Stratford men in the Revolution Pg. 541. Listed on abstract of graves of Revolutionary Patriots.
5. BO6 – **Benjamin, Aaron, Colonel** B-17/Aug/1757, D-21/Nov/1828. Revolutionary War. Pension # W25223, served under Count Casimir Pulaski. He was an Ensign in the 8th CT. Regt. In Jan. 1777 and also served in the 3rd and 5th Regt's. and became a Lt. Col. (Count Pulaski is credited with saving the life of George Washington). His wife Dorothy received a pension. SAR # P-113099
6. No stone – **Benjamin, George, Captain and Fifer** B-28/Feb/1734. D 1779. He served as a Fifer in Capt. Samuel Whiting's Company. He was Capt. of the 1st Co., Col Silliman's Regt. SAR # P113127, DAR # A009119

7. BO7 – **Benjamin, John Bradford, Colonel** B-1730, D-14/Sep/1796. SAR application, Book- Ct. Men in the Revolution. Benjamin served in Col. Huntington's Regiment in 1775, Col. Lamb's Artillery 1777-1783, and Sergeant 1777 2nd Lieutenant 1778. Promoted from Captain 1782 Major of 4th Regiment Danbury Alarm 1777. Col. John Benjamin was a Captain in the Invasion of New Haven on 5 July 1779. Benjamin's Bridge spanned the Mill Creek and was built in 1786 By Col. Benjamin (History of Stratford). SAR # P-113169, DAR # A009125
8. F26 – **Curtiss, Isaac J.**, B-1740, D 17/Jul/1815. In CT. Revolutionary War Military list, 1775-83 page 181. Listed in the History of Stratford PG 543 men in the Revolution. He was in the 4th Regiment, Company Booth's. Ration roll which were detached for the purpose pursuant to order of Brig. Genl. Silliman.
9. JO4 – **Curtiss, Jeremiah**, B-4/Apr/1716, D – 4/Sep/1782 In the Ct. Revolutionary War Military List, 1775-83 page 181. He was in the 4th Regiment, Company Booth's. Ration Roll of Guards detached from the 4th Regt. To the 11th Regt. By order of Brig. Genl. Silliman. DAR # A028878
10. B13 – **Fairchild, John C.**, B-20/Feb/1745, D-2/Feb/1825. Dar# 92175 He joined the 5th regiment, 2nd company, Lieut. Col. Samuel Whiting in command. Also, listed in the U.S., Revolutionary War Rolls, 1775-1783 page 86. SAR # P-156171, DAR #A038558
11. EO5 – **Hubbell, Ezra, Captain** B-2/Sep/1768, D-9/May/1804. Ezra was lost at sea along with his crew in Indonesia. (CT. Church Records Abstracts) Ezra was a Private in the 5th Regiment 9th Company. (Connecticut in the Revolution page 70) SAR Application (1899).
12. G22 – **Hubbell, Silas**, B-1752, D-30/Nov/1812. Silas was an Ensign in Captain Olmsted's Co. on July 6, 1778. (Connecticut Men in the Revolution page 539) SAR application (1943). DAR #A059517
13. P-16 – **Jackson, Daniel**, B- 1763, D- 25 Aug 1841 at age 78 years old. He enlisted 3 times spring of 1778 for 1 year under Captain Yates, again in the spring of 1779 for 9 months under Capt. David Olmsted and finally February of 1782 to the close of the war under Capt. Joseph Walker (who is also buried here). Daniel was in the 2nd Co. 3rd Regt. Conn. Line. He applied for a pension on 2/Apr/1818 at the age of 55. Daniel also owned 1/48 of Fisher's Island and he was a Cooper. His pension # is 36615. SAR # P223849, DAR # A060914
