



This is a fine 19th Century slide arm plough plane. It is marked by a rare 3 \*\*\* Star Maker on toe Hubbell & Lunnagan, NYC with owner name. NOTE: **This maker is rated a 3 star \*\*\* in EMP Guide to American Wooden Planes.** The cutter is marked Moulson Brothers Cast Steel Warranted No 4 and it measures: 8" L x 3/8" W. It is pitted but sharp. The slide arm wedges slide move easily and tighten properly. The brass turn screw and brass trim has been polished. The plane has a nice finish, feel and patina. It has NO issues...just a fine early plough plane ready to use!
