## ROYCE LIST OF BURIALS IN OLD STRATFIELD (PEQUONNOCK) BURYING GROUND

(Copied in 1958 by Mr. Edward N. Coffey of Monroe, Conn., and by Mrs. Edna H. Forsyth of Fairfield, Conn., from the original, then in the possession of Mr. Albert T. Elswick of Bridgeport, Conn. A copy of this Royce list is in the Fairfield Historical Society Library.)

The old Stratfield (Pequonnock) burial ground is located within the quadrangle enclosed by Briarwood Avenue, North Avenue, Brooklawn Avenue and Sterling Place, near the westerly boundary of Bridgeport, Connecticut. In this vicinity the early settlement of Pequonnock Village - later called Stratfield - was made in the year 1639, soon after the first settlement of Fairfield and Stratford. (Note 1)

Copied in 1800 by Rev. Stephen Royce from an old diary of Matthew Sherman and from old church records, this list covers the period from the first burial in 1639 to the year 1799. This list is of particular importance because it expands considerably the list published by Rev. Samuel Orcutt in his <u>History of Stratford and Bridgeport</u> (1886) and his <u>History of Bridgeport</u> (1887).

Rev. Stephen Royce, born about 1756, came from Cheshire, Conn., to Stratfield and was pastor of the Stratfield Baptist Church from 1794 until his death, 3 Aug. 1802. The probate records of his estate, on file at the Connecticut State Library, mention only his widow but no children. He is buried in this old Stratfield burying ground.

Matthew Sherman, son of Samuel<sup>1</sup> and Sarah (Mitchell) Sherman, was born 21 Oct. 1645, recorded at Stratford, Conn. He died at Stratfield in 1698 and was also buried in the old Stratfield ground. His wife, Hannah Bulkley, died in 1712 and is also buried here.

The oldest grave now extant in the cemetery is marked by two stones, one a rude fieldstone, the other a small, smooth slate marker, both bearing only the simple inscription "A.B. 1688" and standing on the top of the little hill which rises in the center of the burial ground and seems to be the oldest part of this ground. This stone corresponds to the "A. Burr 1688" of the Royce list.

The cemetery was little used after 1812 and has been largely neglected for the past century and a half. From time to time efforts have been made to restore it, but, thus far, nothing constructive has been achieved. The last burial in the cemetery was that of Mary Jane Wilson, wife of Abraham W. Morehouse, born 22 May 1837, died 3 Feb. 1920.

A peculiarity of the Royce list is the variance in many of the ages shown, as compared with other records. For example, in the case of Mrs. Deborah Burr who died 4 Dec. 1726, Royce gives her as "aged 52 years" while Orcutt's list (History of Stratford and Bridgeport, 1:559) gives "in ye 52nd year of Her Age," meaning that she was actually 51 rather than 52 years of age. This same variance of one year occurs in a number of instances. The text of the list follows:
