Notes.

These three volumes of original records of the Greenfield Hill or Northwest Society and Church in Fairfield, Connecticut, covering the years 1668-1878, were brought to the Connecticut State Library on January 25, 1932, for permanent deposit by Rev. Carlos C. Rowlinson, pastor of the Church. Such action was taken upon the suggestion and recommendation made by the Manuscript Committee of the Connecticut Society of Colonial Dames in America, with the understanding the church was to receive a photostat copy of the records.

The Greenfield Hill Society was established October 1725 as the Northwest Society in Fairfield by division of the First Society. The name was changed to Greenfield October 1727 and the Hill appears to have been added by usage. Part was set off as part of Norfield Society May 1757, and a small part added October 1757 and part set off as part of North Fairfield Society October 1762.

For the sake of convenience the volume of Society Records has been assigned a number to follow in numerical sequence the other two volumes which were numbered when received in the State Library. Volume I, only partly paged with several series of numbers, has been repaged.
