Part VI Church Meetings & Doings.

Dec. 19 1814 Capt. David Hubbel being in a very weak state, apparently near his end, & earnestly desiring to partake of the holy sacrament of the Lord's Supper; & it appearing moreover that he had formerly been admitted to the privileges of Church membership on the basis of what had been called the half-way covenant; & it further appearing that persons of serious deportment standing in this relation to the Church had been uniformly admitted to the Lord's table on their simply signifying their desire without any previous renewal of their profession in public; - I thought it my duty to call the deacons & some of the principal members of the Church together, & after consultation, & receiving full satisfaction from the applicant with respect to his qualifications, we unanimously resolved to admit comply with his desire, & commended with him accordingly. Test - William Belden Pastor.

Aug 3 1817 At a church meeting holden in the house of God B.M. the following confession of David Down, expressive of his sense of shame & guilt & penitence for the sin of fornication, was read, received & approved, & the offender restored to church fellowship:
 "To the church of Greenfield, Brethren, considering myself an offending member of this church, & having a desire to be restored to the favour & fellowship of the church, so as to be entitled to all its privileges & advantages, & fully bring this my humble confession, acknowledging my sin & folly, & hoping that they will forgive a fault which has ever been since - cause of shame & remorse of conscience on account of its being dis-honour to the religion which I profess. I have humbled myself on this account, & have lain low in the valley of humiliation. I have confessed my sins to God my Saviour, & I humbly trust I have received pardon, for ever blessed be his holy name, that he has brought me over than ever to experience the joy of his salvation."
 Test William Belden, Pastor. "David Down."

Part VI Church Meetings & Doings.

1819 Nov 7 At a church meeting held in the house of God, by previous appointment, immediately after divine service.
 Voted: that the church will hereafter observe the monthly concert of prayer, as is usual in other churches, on the first Monday of each month; & that we will commence in Dec. next.

Test, Will or Belden, Pastor.

At a meeting of the Church held in the house of God April 9th 1821

The following vote was proposed & tried that this Church will not give their consent to the dissolution of the pastoral relation now existing between the Pres^{er} Wm Belden & them & negatived
 Voted that should the consociation of the western district of Fairfield County to be holden at the house on the 7th day of Inst April deem it expedient under all the circumstances of the case to dissolve the pastoral relation now existing between the Pres^{er} Wm Belden from this Church will acquiesce in the determination of P^{er} consociation -
