 David Hubbel & his heirs & Assigns for ever a Certain Tract of Salt meadow in Stratford  
 Township lying in a field called Newfield containing in Quantity about five acres & it is bound  
 east on the meadow formerly belonging to James Shippen late of Stratford Desc<sup>d</sup> South &  
 South west on a Harbour westerly on a Cunn & Bazarler upland for him if Sir David  
 Hubbel do have & to hold a above granted & Bargain. Promise with it appurtenances therof  
 unto him if Sir David Hubbel & his heirs & Assigns for ever so his & their own privy use &  
 Retief - And also I Sir William Boarder do give my self & my heirs ex<sup>t</sup> & Adm<sup>r</sup> Consent  
 with Sir David Hubbel & his heirs & Assigns of it & untill a expiring of three presents  
 am well for of the Premise as a good indefeasible estate in full simple & have good Right to  
 to Bargain & sell it same in Mann<sup>r</sup> & Form as is above written & it the same in full of all  
 incumbrances whatsoever - And farthermore I Sir William Boarder do by these presents bind myself  
 & my heirs for ever to Warrant & Defend & Defend it above granted & Bargain. Promise to
