North Stratford August the 14th 1744 at a Church meeting made choice of Thomas Pett and Thomas Edwards to be our Deacons by a vote of P. Church, and by a vote of our quorum. at the same meeting and by a vote of Thomas Pett or Eleuthere Hubbard in choice of his ab-

North Stratford June the 1st 1745 at a church meeting regular word and conversed on the above P. Day the church made choice of Ephraim Booth to be their Deacon by a close vote

North Stratford November the 21st 1746 at a Church meeting Legally worded in order to chuse a Deacon in the room of Deacon Peter Lalety deceased the Church after several trials not coming to any choice, concluded to return to Friday the 23rd and accordingly it was returned to Friday November the 23rd next according to appointment the meeting being open church made choice of Abraham Bump made to be their Deacon by a close vote

North Stratford Octo the 28th 1746 at a Church Meeting Legally worded vote that Captain Joseph Burton be Depra to tutor the school as an assistant with Deacon Booth vote at the same meeting that the two Deacons Ephraim Booth and Abraham Bump should together with our Brother Noah Johnson be a committee in behalf of the Church to go to our old meeting house near Lake and James Beech and Enquire the reasons of their absenting themselves from our communion in the special Ordinance of the Lords supper. and make report to this church

At a Chh Meeting duly warned & held by Adjourn on the 7th of September 1744

Whereupon an unhappy dispute had for a long time subsisted between two Brethren of this Chh, respecting the bounds of their Land viz David Nicholls & John Barton and particularly respecting some Corn that the sd Barton took off to carry on a trial at Law, on account of which the said Nicholls thought himself aggrieved - and as the said Barton declared himself willing to return the Corn, it was voted by the Chh that as their opinion that the said Barton ought in Justice to return the sd Corn the value thereof to the sd Nicholls, after the Vote was taken & passed both the Parties publicly declared their Acquiescence in sd Vote

May the 6th 1744 there was a Church gathered and held at North Stratford and the same day was ordained their (and took the pastoral charge of that Church) the Rev Mr James Beech by Presbytery, the Rev Mr Ezekiah Good of Stratford, the Rev Mr Ripston John Grayham of Woodbury, John Galloway of Woodbury North Parish, and Benjamin of Westtown (Pastor of Rockbury and Mr Woodbridge of Amity was Present and Preached a sermon from 1 of Amos ch: 9: 1 This is a true saying of a man before the face of a Bishop he doth with a good work

- Mr Good made the first Prayer
- Mr Mills gave the charge
- Mr Galloway gave the right hand of fellowship
- Mr Galloway made the last Prayer
- Mr Cooke Propriet but by sickness indisposed of his part

Here follows a Copy of what was presented to the Church the Male Communicants of Pelham

The Confession of the Christian faith Professed and agreed unto by the Male Communicants in the North Stratford upon their imbruing in to the Estate on May the 6th 1744 at the Ordination of the Rev Mr James Beech to the Pastoral charge of that Church

- 1 We believe there is one only true and ever living God who is the fountain of being and blessedness infinite eternal and unchangeable in his Being and in all his glorious Attributes
- 2 We believe this God and almighty Jehovah is the alone creator of heaven and earth and of all the things contained therein, and that for his own pleasure and for the glory of his own glory they are and derived from him
- 3 We believe that he made us and all mankind to glorify him eternally, by a perfect conformity to his holy will and to be happy in the enjoyment of his blessing forever
- 4 We believe that what ever the most high God would have us to in order to his glory and our own happiness he hath revealed in the holy scriptures of the Old and New Testament, which upon the testimony of our own hearts and the authority of every Church we are bound to believe and receive believe and observe as our only perfect Rule of faith and practice
- 5 We believe that as there is one God so there are many Gods the Godhead of the Father, Son and Holy Ghost and that these three Persons are one God the same in substance equal in Power and glory
- 6 We believe that God by an immutable Purpose according to the counsel of his own will and unchangeable determination all the means whereby he would advance his own glory by his creature, and that he foretold and he executes in the works of creation and Providence an universal Providence over all his creatures from the greatest to the least, and that even in those motions and Events which to us seem most casual and fortuitous there is a Divine Design
- 7 We believe that the glory of God for his creature appears most and his glorious attributes shine brightest in his greatest and most glorious works of man's redemption
- 8 We believe that God at first created man upright after his own Image in knowledge righteousness and holiness gave him Dominion over the inferior part of the creature and took him into a Covenant relation with him in which whosoever life was promised upon perfect obedience and health Personal Spiritual and eternal blessedness upon the first fall from God and that God thus gave us such a stake of grace as might be sufficient for us and that in that Covenant man stood as the common or public head and representative of all his ordinary Posterity
- 9 We believe that our first Parents being left to the free use of their own will, did voluntarily Breake that Covenant of works by eating of the forbidden fruit and by that act of rebellion incurred the curse and all his posterity became guilty before God and the way to life and happiness by that Covenant impossible by him or themselves by the curse of the Law no flesh living can be justified
- 10 We believe that God from eternity had in himself a purpose of love and mercy to man for some of his posterity guilty before him to glorify the riches of his grace and Salvation, the manner of which was that he should send the eternal Counsel of an Covenant of redemption in the person of his only Son Jesus Christ the Son of God became man, being conceived by the power of the Holy Ghost in the womb of the virgin Mary and born of her yet without sin and that having thus

to be god and man two distinct natures and one person for ever.

We believe that Jesus Christ as our Redeemer is imaged with and executes the threefold office of Prophet Priest and King and that heath in that his state of humiliation and exaltation

We believe that this the Christ of god was born in a low condition under the sorrows of this life ^{born in a low condition} and that the law was fulfilled in him and that he was crucified dead and buried and continued in the state of the dead until the third day that then he arose again from the dead according to the scriptures ascended into heaven and sat down on the right hand of the mighty on high, where he ever lives to make intercession continual intercession for his people, and that all Principalities and Powers of Dominion and Powers are made subject unto him and all Power in heaven and earth put into his hand

We believe that Jesus Christ the faithful and true witness of god his operations according to the promise sent forth the holy spirit to carry on and effectuate his work continually: and that it is by the alone efficacy of this blessed spirit convincing and enlightning and changing or renewing those minds, working faith in them and thereby enabling them to christ, that all the redemption of the lost are made Redeemers of all the benefits of redemption purchased by his precious blood.

We believe that such as are especially called by the spirit of god to faith in christ are justified before god only through the perfect righteousness of the lord Jesus imputed to them by an act of faith: and that with faith in christ they receive Dominion to become the children of god and are invested with all the ~~benefits~~ ^{benefits} of the Kingdom of god: and that they hear in conquest the change of their state

fairly believe the necessity of a change of nature as well as of state in that that one hairs of eternal life that their nature must be changed, and they must receive a new and divine nature by the efficacy of the holy spirit, implanting a Principle of having right faith and love in their hearts without any thing in their selves or ought that they can do to fit or dispose them selves for it, or oblige god to the bestowment of it, and that all such as are thus called justified and renewed shall undoubtedly be kept by the mighty Power of god through faith into eternal Salvation

We believe the lord Jesus Christ who purchased his church with his own blood is the only King of Zion and head of his church, and that none other hath Dominion over him as lord over his own house but constituted standing Officers in his church, and the Qualifications duties and to the several parts of his worship, and his office in the Church such as the word Sacraments Prayers and Praise which are to be received observed and kept pure and entire by us as they are believed to us of himself in his holy word: that he always will have a Church on earth up to him for a generation against which shall be accounted for that none be able to prevail

We believe that there are but two Sacraments of the new Testament (viz) Baptism and the washing with water in the name of the father son and holy ghost, to which all professing faith in christ with their consent shall have a right which we do look upon the visible seal of initiating seals of the covenant of grace, and the Lords Supper wherein by giving and receiving bread and wine Christs death is showed forth his dying love Remembred according to his command, and all the special and saving benefits thereof conveyed and applied to the worth receive and that in the strict use of this we are to maintain of communion of saints and shew forth the Lords death till he come again

We believe that at death the souls of believers are made perfect in holiness and enter into the possession of heaven by glory in the immediate presence of god, and that their bodies being united to christ, tho' kept in their graves till the resurrection, whereof the souls of the wicked to immediately go to hel to be under the dreadful wrath and vengeance of our mighty god forever and ever

We believe there will be a Resurrection of all the dead both of the just and the unjust according to a final Judgment, and that Jesus Christ being raised with a new body of god shall execute that Judgment, openly and openly and making them completely blessed in the full and eternal possession of god but shall turn the wicked into hel with all the nations that forget god.

All these sayings we believe to be faithful and true built on the foundation of the apostles and Prophets Jesus Christ himself being the chief Corner Stone, and steadfastly preserved by the grace of Consistency to asperse unto our lives, Amen
