The present year has been one of great moment in the history of this church. During the month of January there was evidence of a deeper sense of responsibility & of dependence on God, & more earnestness in prayer on the part of some members of the church; and early in February the word began to take effect in the hearts of the impudent. From that time onward until about the first of June, the convincing & comforting influences of the Holy Spirit were granted in a gentle but most deeply interesting manner. Meetings were held more frequently than usual during three or four months, the pastor being absent by several of the neighboring brethren, & for a part of four weeks by him Mr. Hurd, recently dismissed from Watertown. No particular system of measures has been adopted, but various means have been used to lead inquiring sinners to make known the state of their minds, such as "the inquiring meeting," "re- maining for conversation after meetings," & "the anxious seat." The last has been most successful, & most productive of good impressions on the minds of professing Christians.

As the result of this blessed outpouring of the Spirit,

about fifty persons have expressed hope in Christ, nearly half of whom are heads of families. Thirty seven have been added to the church on profession of their faith, (several of whom had indulged hope before,) & from 15 to 20 have as yet neglected to confess Christ before men for various reasons, some of which it is feared are sinful.

But notwithstanding this great blessing bestowed on this church, our contributions for the spread of the gospel have not advanced in the least; meetings for social prayer & praise & communion, have been nearly as thin since the first of July as during the same months of last year; and it is believed by the pastor that there is as great a want of brotherly love. In view of these things, & of the opposition, on the part of some, to nearly all his plans & efforts to do good, the pastor has felt it to be his duty to inquire of the Church & Society whether they wish for a further continuance of his labors among them, & if so whether they will endeavor to sustain & encourage him by a prompt & faithful discharge of their duties towards himself, & towards the cause of Christ. The first of these inquiries was promptly met by a large & almost unanimous vote in the affirmative. The Society also voted to increase the salary from \$450 to \$500. Other things however, which the pastor deemed essential to his usefulness & to the permanent prosperity of the church, were treated lightly, in consequence of which & of the belief in his own mind that several prominent members of the Church & Society were willing & even desirous that he should leave, the pastor asked the church to unite with him in calling the Council of Association to council & advise as to the expediency of his dismission. The Council met on the 20th day of Nov. And although an effort was made by the Church & Society's Committee, to convince the Council that there had not been sufficient cause for calling the Council, yet it was their opinion after a careful & patient hearing that the connection between this church & people & their pastor had better be dissolved. The disputation therefore took place on this twentieth day of Nov. 1844. By invitation, the dismissed pastor occupied the pulpit on the following Sabbath & gave a farewell discourse from Job. 20:1.
