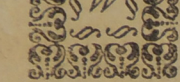


To the Sheriff of the County of *Tainpfeil*

within said County, **Greeting.**

**HEREAS** *Ichvoramus Waklee* of *S. Shalfor*



*John Hubble* of *S. Shalfor* Recovered Judgment against  
before the *County*  
Court, Holden at *Tainpfeil* within the County aforesaid, On the  
*this* Tuesday of *April 1751* for the Sum of *£97:6:0*  
Debt, *ad lev* and for the Sum of  
*£7:12:8* Costs of Suit, as appears of  
Record: Whereof Execution remains to be done.

**T**H E S E are therefore in His Majesty's Name to Command you, That of  
the Goods, Chattels, or Lands of the said *Hubble*  
within your Precincts, you cause to be Levied, ( and the same being Disposed of, or  
Apprized as the Law directs ) Paid, and Satisfied unto the said *Waklee*  
The aforesaid Sums being *one hundred and four pence* *18/8*  
*in the Whole*; with *one Shilling Proclamation* more for this Writ; and  
thereof also to Satisfy your self for your own Fees. And for want of such Goods,  
Chattels, or Lands of the said *Hubble* to be by him shewa unto  
you, or found within your Precincts, to the Acceptance of the said *Waklee*  
for the Satisfying of the aforesaid Sums, you are hereby Comanded  
to Take the Body of the said *Hubble* and him Commit unto the  
Keeper of the Goal in *Tainpfeil* in the County aforesaid, within the said  
Prison; Who is likewise hereby Comanded to Receive the said *Hubble*  
and him safely Keep, until he Pay unto the said *Waklee* the full  
Sums above-mentioned, and be Released by Order of Law, and also Satisfy your Fees.  
Hereof Fail not, and make due Return of this Writ, with your Doings thereon  
within Sixty Days, according to Law. Dated at *Tainpfeil* this  
*25<sup>th</sup>* Day of *April* Anno Domini, 1751 And in the *24<sup>th</sup>*  
Year of His Majesty's Reign.
