before you came to the salt marsh on the south
and bounded on the northeast at the parsonage
and west and south west with the land of Daniel
Lilimans do~~sed~~ which hay: I judge to be
worth twelve shillings ^{in pay} of about 5 meadow
which I sold to the about 5 Wakeman money
last year.
