& assigns hereafter, viz. One Certain piece of Land with a Dwelling House, Barn & fruit trees
on ^{the} same, Containing three acres & one Quarter of an acre, ^{the} Land lying in ^{the} town of
Ridgefield Near ^{the} Church, & is bounded East & West by highway North by Caleb
Lockells Land, South by Jacob Smiths Land together with all ^{the} Appurtenances thereto
belonging, To have & to hold ^{the} above Granted & bargained premises with all ^{the} Appur-
tenances therof unto him ^{the} R. Nathan Stabbell his heirs & assigns forever, unto his & their
own proper use benefit & behoof, forever free & Clear of all Encumbrances whatsoever.

Furthermore I ^{the} R. William Carpenter do by these presents bind ^{my} self, my heirs
& assigns forever to Warrant & Defend ^{the} above Granted & bargained premises with
all ^{the} appurtenances therof unto him ^{the} R. Nathan Stabbell his heirs & assigns against
