Know all Men by these presents that I Josiah Hubbel of Stratford in the County of Newfane in the Colony of Connecticut for in Consideration of thirty Nine pounds Money in hand Received and well & truly paid by Samuel Judson of ye same County & State aforsw to my full satisfaction & Content Hand & sealed by these presents to fully freely clearly & solubly set alons of & for ever give grant & confirm unto Samuel Judson afsd & to his Heires executors & assigns for ever two or acres of land lying in the Woods on ye North of this Country Rhoad against ye New pasture as it now or by which I purchased & received from Ephraim Judson bounded North on land laid out to me Sam'l Sherman & west on land of Con' Broth South on land laid out to Benjn Nicoll & Benjn Sherman & east on land laid out to John Hurd as appears of Record for him held Samuel Judson his Heires & assigns to have hold & posse & peaceably to enjoy ye afsd two or acres of land with all privileges & immunitiess therunto belonging as his & thare own proper estate & inheritance for ever: without any molestation or disturbance or disturbance wthoue of or by me the said Josiah Hubbel my Heires or Executors or from any other person or persons whomsoever laying any lawful claim thereto affirming my self to be the true proprietor and of I have in my self full power to sell the same in Massach as afsd & free & clear & clearly acquitted & exonerated & discharged of & from all other & former gifts grants bargains sales mortgaes jointures Towns will beates & encumbrances & what so ever and I do further bind & oblige my self my Heires & executors from henceforth & for ever hereafter to warrant & defend all the aforesaid premises & the appurtenances therof to the said Samuel Judson his Heires & assigns against the lawful claims and demands of all persons whomsoever in witness & set to my hand & seal in Stratford this fifth Day of June 1717 —
