his heirs executors admistrs & assignes for ouer a part or parcel of land lying situated & being in ye limitts boundes & precincts of Stratford afores^t
containing two acres & one quarter or it more or less & is bounded on ye north with said Hubbells own land on ye west with ye highway between Stratford & fairfield
on ye south with land belonging to ye estate of Sam^t Gregory deceased & on ye east with ye said wrights own land to have & to hold ye said parcel of land
together with all ye rights therunto belonging or in any wise appertaining & ye same to possess & enjoy as his own free estate & inheritance for ouer
without any lat claime or molestation from me my heires executors & admistrs or any other person or persons by whom or under whom or any of us the dñe

 County of Fairfield & Colony of Connecticut Planter certain tracts or parcels of land in a place called ye now
 pasture in ye bounds of Stratford as followeth Imprimis my home lot of two acres less it more or less with
 a Barn on it being bounded north w^t ye highway or Country road east with a highway south with land of
 Nathaniel Sherman west with land of Samuel peat & nine acres of land less it more or less bounded east with
 a highway south with land formerly Timothy Wilcoxson west with land of John peat north w^t a highway
 also five acres & a halfe less it more or less bounded & east with ye highway north with highway & common
 fence south & west with D pigglee our land: and my three Miles division land as it is bounded in the
 Town records of say I have sold alienated Conveyed & confirmed at ye aforesd parcels of land with all rights
 privileges & appurtenances therunto belonging unto William Pigglee aforesd to have & to hold to him his Heires
 and Assigns fore ever affirming my self to be ye true proprietor of al ye premises & of I have in my self good
 right full power & lawful authority to alienate & sell ye same & every part thereof is free from all former
 bargaines sales Mortgages foymures dower or other incumbrances whatsoe^r & I say I have sold al ye premises to
 the said William Pigglee his Heires & assigns for & in consideration of ye summe of eighty five pounds & ten shillings
 secured to be paid as by his bill bearing date with these presents may more fully appear I doo also further
 concurant & promise for me my heires & executors to William Pigglee his Heires & assigns to give them
 any other deed or Conveyance of al or any of ye said parcels of land before mentioned & they by these
 Councill learned in ye law shal be aduised unto them being at ye charge of ye same witness my hand
 and seal this fourteenth of December in ye year of our Lord one thousand five hundred ninety & four
