Now al more by these presents of Josiah Hubbell of Stratford in yo Colony of Connecticut in New England for a valuable consideration in hand received & well & truly paid by my father in law in former
 wily of Stratford in yo Colony aforesd to my full satisfaction & content Hansford & by these presents do fully freely & lawfully & absolutely sell alienate assigne let use give grant & confirm unto
 Hansford aforesd & to his heirs executors & assigns for ever a certain tract of full meadow lying at Nesumpow on the east & south of yo largest Hill be it more or less bounded on yo North
 westerly with yo Hill & east with yo land & west with Nesumpow's creek & south with yo land & creek for him yo said Hansford Hawley his heirs & assigns to have & hold unto yo said
 yo aforesd meadow as above bounded wth all commoners thereto belonging as his & thoro own proper estate & for his heirs & assigns for ever without let or molestation from me yo said Josiah Hubbell my heirs
 executors or from or by any other person whomsoever laying any lawful claim yete or any part ye of affirming my self yo lawful owner of yo aforesd meadow & yo said Hansford
 in manner aforesd & of free & clear of all incumbrances & of do further covenant bind & oblige my self my heirs & executors yo aforesd meadow & granted premises to yo said Hansford
 wily his heirs & assigns against yo lawful claims & demands of al persons to warrant & defend & to give & pass such further confirmation of yo aforesd granted premises as in law or
 equity can be reasonably advised or required in Testimony whereof first to my hand & seal in Stratford this 6th day of May 1713: Josiah Hubbell *Soul*
