by a field meadow as above bounded w^t commoners H^t to Colby as his & his own proper estate & hereditam for ever without let or molestation from me & said Joseph Hobble my husband
and in manner aforesd & for & close of all incumbrances & so further (omitting his & his heirs & assigns against me) I do further Covenant bind & obligate my self full power to sell this
land to be reasonably advised or required in Testimony whereof first to my hand & seal in Stratford this 6th day of May 1713: Josiah Hobble Sealed
