

2023: AMARILLO, Texas (KAMR/KCIT) — An Amarillo man was sentenced to 99 years in prison and has to pay a \$10,000 fine for a charge of murder reported to the 47th District Attorney's Office.

Matthew Hubbell was sentenced to 99 years in prison for the murder of his mother.

According to the 47th DA, Randall Sims, in September 2019, Matthew Hubbell had called someone for help to dispose of a body.

The person called the Amarillo Police Department and helped them identify and find Hubbell.

APD secured a search warrant for Hubbell's home and found the body of Jane Love, Hubbell's mother in the crawl space.

In May, a jury found Hubbell guilty of murder and he was sentenced to 99 years in prison and required to pay a \$10,000 fine, the maximum punishment available.
